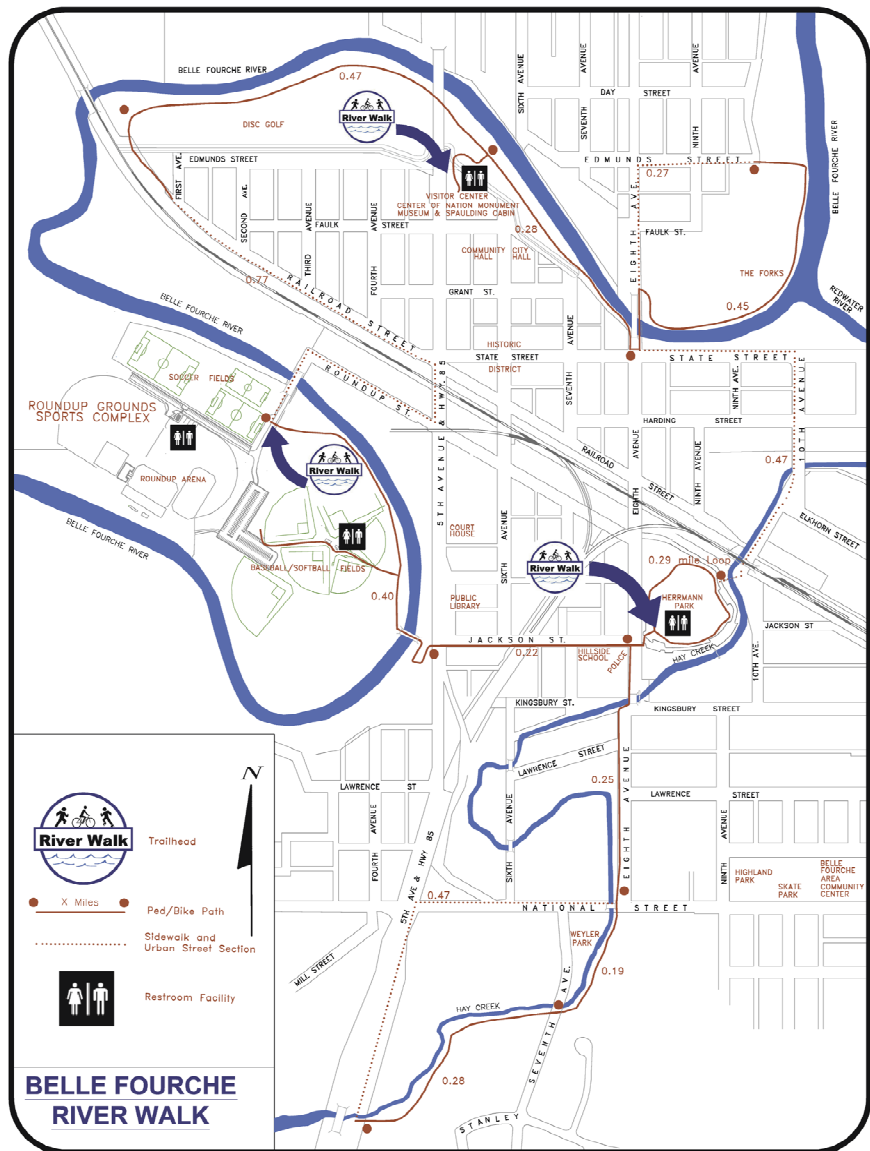


# BELLE FOURCHE RIVER WALK TRAILHEAD
