Whereas, Human milk reduces risk of infectious and chronic disease; protects the health and mothers and infants, and may reduce the risk of SIDS, diarrhea, asthma, diabetes, childhood obesity, and certain childhood cancers; and,

Whereas, Keeping breastfeeding high on the public health agenda is critical to improving the health and well-being of mothers and infants in South Dakota; and,

Whereas, South Dakota joins professional health organizations and breastfeeding advocates worldwide in celebrating World Breastfeeding Week 2017 to collaboratively raise awareness of the numerous benefits of breastfeeding; to strengthen individual, family, and community support for breastfeeding; to further strategies that protect optimal breastfeeding practices; and to encourage increased breastfeeding rates; and to celebrate the 2017 theme, "Sustaining Breastfeeding Together":
